






7. Power Supply Interface



E Installation


Clean the windshield and paste the electrostatic film onto it Avoid introducing air bubble. DO NOT paste the film repeatedly.

Paste the device onto the electrostatic film and route cable to the disaster box for power supply.




Adjustthe angle to the target direction.

## G Basic Description

#### Start Up

Connectthe power cord to the car battery.

#### Start Up/Shut Down Manually

Hold the power button for 3 s to shut down the device. Press the power button to start up the device.

## Recording

Recordings are divided to ordinary video and emergency video. You can setthe video voice on/off via System Settings or Hikdashcam APP.

### Upgrade

Step1: Power on the device and connectitto Wi-Fi. Step2: Run the Hikdashcam APP, add the device to download upgrading package. Step3: Upgrade the device.

### Safety Instruction

- In the use of the dashcam, you must be in strict compliance with the local laws and regulations.
- You are recommended to install the dashcam on the location of rear mirror to ensure the dashcam can record with the best surveillance view. DO NOT install the dashcam on the location that will block the driver's sight.
- Keep the user manual properly for future reference. See initial connection of dashcam in user manual.
- Purchase the TF card from legal channel. To ensure safe and stable data transmission, it is recommended to use TF card of Class 10 or above.
- Formatthe new TF card first before using the card.
- To protect TF card from damage, shut down the dashcam before installing and uninstalling TF card.
- If the dashcam is directly connected with the vehicle power system, you are recommended to power off the dashcam when the engine is off. Disconnect cigarette lighter to avoid insufficient voltage and abnormal startup. Reconnect cigarette lighter to ensure dashcam work normally when you start the car again.
- Operating temperature is from -20°C to 70°C (-4°F to 158°F). To protectthe dashcam, DO NOT use itin high temperature, low temperature, or high-humidity environment. Keep the dashcam from rain and dust.
- The manual is subject oupdate. The functions of dashcam may vary according to different models.

\*The driving assistance function of the device only sends alarm or warning to the driver and cannot replace the driver's judgement and operation. Trouble	Solution
The dashcam drops easily.	<ul> <li>Clean the windshield before installation.</li> <li>Check whether the 3M tape is tightly sticked to the electrostatic film before the installation.</li> </ul>
Starting the dashcam failed.	<ul> <li>Check whether the vehicle is started and power supply is normal.</li> <li>Check whether the car charger is tightly connected.</li> <li>Restore to defaults: hold the <b>RESET</b> button until the startup music is heard.</li> </ul>
The dashcam powers off easily.	<ul> <li>Make sure the power cord is in good condition.</li> <li>Make sure the power cord is tightly connected to the according interfaces.</li> </ul>
Recording is abnormal and indicator is unlit.	<ul> <li>Make sure thatthe dashcam started up successfully.</li> <li>Check whether the TF card is inserted.</li> <li>Check the status of TF card, e.g. its format, its lifespan.</li> <li>Change TF card ifitis not well.</li> </ul>
Recording is blurred.	<ul> <li>Make sure the protective film is peeled off.</li> <li>Check whether the windshield or the lens of dashcam is blurred.</li> </ul>
Recording is mute.	<ul> <li>Set audio settings on the device or turn on sound recording in HikDashcam app.</li> <li>Turn on sound through the the audio control function ofthe dashcam.</li> </ul>
Dashcam reboots itself.	<ul> <li>Check whether the car charger is tightly connected.</li> <li>Check whether the car charger is equipped with power supply interface of 5 VDC, ≥ 2 A.</li> </ul>
Mobile phone cannot connectto dashcam.	<ul> <li>Make sure HikDashcam app is installed.</li> <li>Please restartthe dashcam to the app.</li> </ul>

# H Troubleshooting

Trouble	Solution
The mobile phone cannot display recordings.	<ul> <li>It may be relevant with the player or system of the phone. Please connect TF card to your computer ar display the recordings.</li> </ul>
TF card is not detected when you connect dashcam to computer with the supplied power cord.	<ul> <li>Dashcam does not support data transmission and the supplied power cord is only for charging.</li> <li>If you need to transfer data, please connect TF card to your computer.</li> </ul>
Wi-Fi connection takes a long time.	<ul> <li>It may be caused by the interferrence of the surrounding Wi-Fi signals. Please use the dashcam i an environment of less interferrence.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Shut down unnecessary programs in your phone to release some resources for HikDashcam app and reconnect Wi-Fi.</li> </ul>
Dashcam Wi-Fi password is forgotten.	<ul> <li>The default password is 1234567890. If you have revisied the password, regain the password by the following steps.</li> <li>Hold the <b>RESET</b> button on dashcam until the star music is heard and the dashcam is restored to defaults.</li> </ul>
	<ol> <li>Go to Wi-Fi Connection interface in HikDashcam app.</li> <li>Select Wi-Fi SSID and log in with default passwor 1234567890.</li> </ol>
No GPS signal.	<ul> <li>D34507 690.</li> <li>Check whether the GPS function is enabled.</li> <li>Normally, the GPS function is enabled by default.</li> <li>Make sure the device is notin the places of weak signal or no signal, such as underground garage.</li> <li>Make sure there is no metal around the device because metal will interfere with GPS signal.</li> <li>Make sure the location where the device is installen not pastd with GPS signal.</li> </ul>
